Dr. Christine M. Crawford is the Associate Director of Medical Student Education in Psychiatry and an Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at Boston University School of Medicine. She also serves as the Associate Medical Director for the National Alliance of Mental Illness (NAMI).

Dr. Crawford completed her adult psychiatry residency as well as child and adolescent psychiatry fellowship training at Massachusetts General Hospital/McLean Hospital. She received her M.D. from the University of Connecticut School of Medicine and her Master's in Public Health from Boston

University School of Public Health where she concentrated in Social and Behavioral Sciences.

Dr. Crawford has been engaged in a number of community outreach initiatives through the Boys and Girls Club of Boston, NAACP and NAMI.
